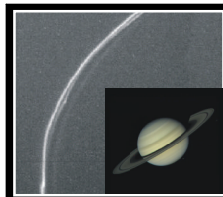

## 1. Rings of Saturn:

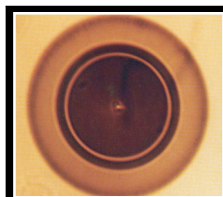
Saturn's entire ring structure is very complex and difficult to explain via evolution. One of the rings, the "F" ring (see picture) has an intricate, unstable "braiding" feature that leaves evolutionists at a loss when trying to describe how this could have persisted for more than a few thousand years.

Examples: Clown fish and sea anemones, Yucca plants and yucca moths, Termites and their parasites.

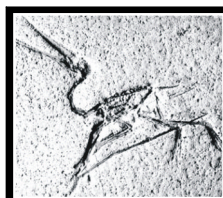

There are many facts that point to rapid, catastrophic conditions which killed without warning.

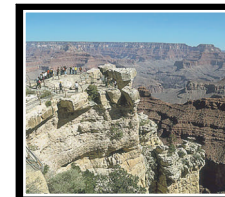
- Large groups of iguanodons killed simultaneously.

## 5. Global Catastrophe:

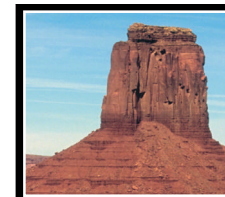
Around the world, we find enormous layers of sedimentary rock (rock that is formed in water), proving that at one time the earth was covered in water. Signs of massive runoff, such as the Grand Canyon, show that it happened quickly.

## 7. Coal Beds:

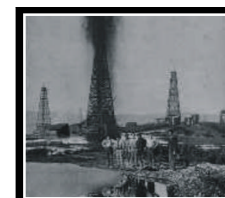
Human objects, such as the bell pictured here, found inside coal beds prove that humans existed before the formation of coal.

## 8. Oil Deposits:

Oil is frequently found at extremely high pressures. It is not possible for the rock to have contained this pressure for millions of years; therefore, the oil was formed recently and under great pressure. The size of the deposits indicates that they must have been produced in a recent catastrophe like Noah's Flood.

## 10. Jesus:

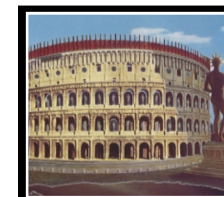

## 12. Gutenberg:

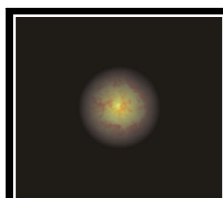

## 1. Big Bang:

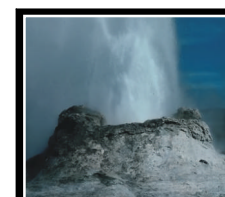
